

WE ARE ALSO A TRINITY

The more accurate translation we suggested in the previous article (Who Created The Heavens And The Earth?) further enlightens us to the fact that the triune Godhead (God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit), existed from the beginning and created all things that exist today. It also illuminates scriptures such as Genesis 1:26, “²⁶Then God said, “*Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air, over the livestock, over all the earth, and over all the creatures that move along the ground.*” (Genesis 1:26 New International Version)

As we shared in article GE-6 (God’s Image), when the Bible tells us that Adam and Eve were made in the image of God, it does not mean that they had two arms because God has two arms. That is not the image of God in which they were made.

God is a trinity, that is, our God manifests himself to us in three ways. God the Father represents the intellect of God. God the Son represents the material part of God and God the Holy Spirit represents the spiritual part of God. It is impossible for our human minds to completely understand how God can be three and yet can be one. We find, however, that in John 14:9 Jesus Christ told his disciples that “*he that hath seen me hath seen the Father.*”

Man is also a trinity. In fact, man is the only creation of God that was created a trinity. We have a material body (1st Corinthians 15:44), a spiritual body (1st Corinthians 15:44) and we have intellect, that is to say, we have the ability to think and make decisions of our own free will (Romans 7:15-25 and Joshua or Josue 24:14-15).
